# Joseph Bridge

#### **Summary Timeline**

- **6th June 1823**: Joseph Bridge is born to Henry/Harry (a weaver) and Alice Bridge in Harwood, Bolton. He was the eldest of 8 children, with siblings Mary, Betty, Alice, Jane, John and James, Robert and Edwin.
- 12th June 1823: Joseph is baptised at St Anne's Church, Tottington.
- **6th June 1841:** (*Probably*) Joseph is lodging at Chipfield, Bury with the Carter family. Joseph is a cotton power weaver, while his landlord is a sawyer.
- **17 June 1848:** Joseph marries Sarah Nuttall at Mary the Virgin Church, Bury, Sarah was born 21st May 1829, the daughter of Thomas (a shopkeeper) and Allice Nuttall of Booth Lane, Tottington.
- 22nd March 1850: Sarah gives birth to daughter Alice.
- **31st March 1850**: Alice is baptised at St Anne's Church, Tottington. Joseph's occupation is given as "Sawyer".
- **4th August 1850:** Alice is baptised for a second time, again at St Anne's Church, Tottington. Joseph's occupation is given as "Joiner".
- **30th March 1851:** Joseph and Sarah are living at Buckley Wells, Bury, with their baby daughter Alice and Sarah's brother Joseph Nuttall (a butcher)
- 11th October 1852: Sarah gives birth to daughter Betsy.
- **26th December 1852**. Betsy is baptised at All Saints Church, Elton. Joseph's occupation is given as "Joiner".
- **20th February 1854**: Sarah gives birth to daughter Elizabeth.
- **2nd November 1856:** Elizabeth is baptised at All Saints Church, Elton. Joseph's occupation is given as "Joiner".
- ~1857: Sarah dies.
- **Q2 1858**: Joseph Bridge marries Ann Kay in Bury/Tottington. Ann was born 10th June 1832, the daughter of Robert (a weaver) and Nancy Kay of Walshaw Lane, Tottington.
- **24th June 1859:** Ann gives birth to daughter Mary Alice in Bury.
- **10th January 1860:** Mary Alice is baptised at All Saints Church, Elton. Joseph's occupation is given as "Sawyer".
- **7th April 1861:** Joseph, Ann and their 4 children are living (briefly) in Green Street, Radcliffe (now the site of Dunelm Mills and a car park/gipsy camp).
- ~June 1861: Ann gives birth to daughter Jane Ann.
- Between Q2 1861 and Q4 1862: the family moves to 7 Barker Street, Bury.
- **21st December 1862:** Jane Ann dies at Barker Street, Bury, and is buried at St Anne's Church, Tottington.
- **28th November 1863:** Ann gives birth to son Thomas in Bury.
- **3rd July 1864:** Thomas is baptised at All Saints Church, Elton. Joseph's occupation is given as "Turner".
- **Q2 1866:** Joseph dies in Bury, aged 43.
- ~1866-7: Ann gives birth to daughter Sarah Emily.
- **2nd April 1871:** The widow Ann is still living in Barker Street with the 6 children, and is taking in washing. The 4 eldest children are all wool weavers.

#### **Questions**

- Why was the first child, Alice, baptised twice? Did they initially think she wasn't going to survive, so she was hastily baptised when she was just a few days old?
- Why did the family move briefly to Radcliffe around 1861?
- Why was Jane Ann apparently never baptised?
- Why was Jane Ann buried at St Anne's Church rather than All Saints that the family normally used?

#### Missing Data

For completeness, details on the following need digging out or confirming:

- 1841 census record for Joseph. (From the census record of his parents and siblings, we know he had left home, so he was probably lodging somewhere in the Bury area. There are two possible records, depending whether his age the census was taken on his 18th birthday was rounded up to 20 or down to 15. From his job as a cotton weaver, and his landlord's as a sawyer, the lodging in Chipfield, Bury seems the most likely.)

- Death of Joseph
- Birth of Sarah Emily

# Death (Joseph)

Has to be between 1866 (birth of last child) and 1871 (when Ann is listed as a widow)

The only full record I can find is for 11th October 1868 in Bury, but it gives his age as either 57 or 67 (it's been altered but I can't tell which way). In either case that is far too old. In 1868 he would have been 45.
